Are you looking for a quality pre-school opportunity for your child?

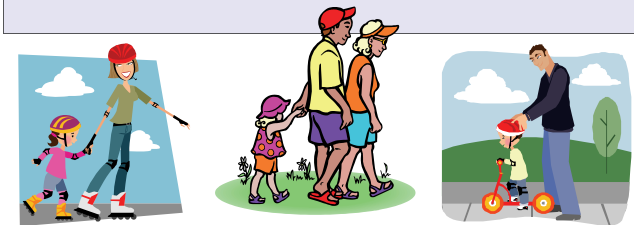
Head Start offers an exceptional experience for children and their families.
